## Premium Wine under Coravin by the glass

### White

**Sicily - 2017 Planeta -Eurzione 1614 Carricante DOC 22.50**

Carricante is at home on Mount Etna where it grows at high altitude and is capable of making wines with great longevity and with a mineral character. It has an ability to ripen at high altitudes and is considered to make some of Italy's best white wines. Planeta is a famous Sicilian producer and this version shows flinty aromas and a lemon, green apple aromas, not unlike a dry Riesling

**Slovenica - 2020 Marko Fon Malvazija 23.75**

Marko works his vineyards, one of which is over one hundred years old (interestingly, called Quattro Stati, as it has been in four different countries, as borders have moved over the last 100 years), entirely by hand without use of herbicides, fertilizers, and systemic treatments. In the cellar the grapes are fermented on skins for a few days and aged in a combination of stainless steel and cask before being bottled unfiltered and unfiltered. Marko's Malvasia is a beautifully crafted wine with distinctive floral notes and ripe stone fruit, the palate brimming with energy and finishing with a briny tang.

#### Piemonte – 2018 Poderi Colla Barolo Brussia DOCG 39.25

Barolo DOCG Bussia 'Dardi Le Rose' This 7 hectare vineyard at Dardi is one of the sub-zones (soprana) of the prestigious hillside cru of Bussia, located outside the village of Monforte d'Alba. Bussia is renowned for Barolo of great depth and concentration with mineral and animal notes. Typically, this has brooding aromas of scorched earth, spices and tobacco that lead to rich, complex layers of dried figs, plums and prunes that gradually open on the palate, finishing long and sweet. Always approachable in youth, always rewarding with long term cellaring.

#### Tuscany - 2016 Giorgio Ugolfotre Brunello di Montalcino DOCG

**36.25 glass** Tenuta San Giorgio is located on the slopes of Monte Amiata which is some of the most important growing area for Brunello. The Ugolforte Brunello comes from the oldest vines and is made in the traditional manor using large wooden barrels which give rise to velvety red wines. It's a full and opaque wine with pure black cherry, slight earthy, porcini notes and chewy tannins.
